


## Does GDPR apply to your work?

This flowchart is intended to help non-profit organisations and associations based in Hong Kong understand whether the GDPR may apply to them.



## Definitions

**EEA** means the European Economic Area (the 27 EU member states and Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway). The EEA does not include Switzerland.

**EU GDPR** means Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation)

**GDPR** means the EU GDPR and UK GDPR.

**Personal data** means any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual. They can be identified directly or indirectly. Identifiers can include names, identification numbers, locations, and economic, cultural or social factors.

**Processing** means any action performed on data including collection, recording, organisation, storage, changing, use, disclosure, dissemination, combining with other data, or erasure.

**UK GDPR** means the EU GDPR as it is retained in UK law following the UK's withdrawal from the EU.
