


VENUE AND MAP OF THE AREA

TRANSPORTATION TO THE VENUE



Upon arrival in Bangkok, participants are expected to make travel arrangements to and from the respective airports. The following guide will provide the different travel options to Eastin Sathorn.

*Please note that Bangkok has two airports:

(1) Suvarnabhumi Airport and (2) Don Mueang Airport

(1) Suvarnabhumi Airport

Thailand's **main** airport. Both departure and arrival flights are available to/from **domestic** and **foreign** destinations.

(2) Don Mueang Airport

It serves as a **secondary hub for low-cost flights**, for both domestic and international destinations.

Address: 222 Vibhavadi Rangsit Road, Sanambin, Don Mueang, Bangkok, Thailand



TAXI AND "GRAB" RIDE HAILING SERVICES

Metered taxis can be found outside the arrivals hall at **both** airports.

From Suvarnabhumi Airport:

- 1. Follow the sign "Public Taxi."
- 2. When you reach the taxi stand, choose the "Regular Taxi" lane.
- 3. There should be a ticket machine where you can obtain a ticket.
- 4. Go to the lane number printed on your ticket.





The taxi cost includes a <u>50 Baht airport surcharge</u>, <u>expressway fees</u>, and the taxi fare (<u>500-600 Baht depending on traffic</u>).

It takes around <u>45-60 minutes</u> to reach the hotel, outside of rush hour.

From Don Mueang International Airport:

- 1. Follow the sign "Taxi" to reach the taxi stand.
- 2. Press the button to get the ticket.
- 3. Go to the number printed on your ticket.

The taxi cost includes a **50 Baht airport surcharge**, **expressway fees, and the taxi fare**.



It takes around <u>45-60 minutes</u> to reach the hotel, outside of rush hours.

You may also download the "<u>Grab</u>" hailing application and utilize their services. When using metered taxis please always make sure the meters are turned on.

The Forum venue also offers airport pick-ups and you may reach out directly to the **hotel** to arrange a pick-up at your own cost.



Airport Rail Link from Suvarnabhumi Airport



The Airport Rail Link Line departs every 10-15 minutes. Alight at the last stop, i.e., **Phaya Thai Station** (see the arrows above).



Switch from the Airport Rail Link to the **Sukhumvit Line of the BTS Skytrain**.

Take the train in the direction of **Kheha**.

You are required to make an interchange at the **Siam BTS Station**.

Then take the <u>Silom Line in the direction of Bing</u>
<u>Wa</u>, to reach <u>Surasak BTS station</u>.

It takes around **1 hour** and costs **120 Baht** in total.

This option is recommended if you have little luggage and during morning or evening


Airport Shuttle Bus: A3 from Don Mueang International Airport

- 1. Take the <u>A3 airport shuttle bus</u> towards <u>Lumpini</u>

 <u>Park</u>, which departs every 10-15 minutes and alight <u>at the stop of Lumpini Park</u>.
- 2. Then walk around 3 minutes to the Ratchadamri station of the BTS Skytrain system and take the Silom Line towards Bang Wa to reach Surasak BTS station.

It takes around **1.5 hours** and costs **90 Baht** in total.

Once you have arrived at the Surasak BTS station, the hotel is just next to the station and requires a 5-minute walk.

THAI CULTURE AND ETIQUETTE

Thailand is a country with rich cultural traditions. Here are a few basic guidelines:



Wai

A traditional Thai greeting with hands pressed together in front of the chest.



Foot-related Actions

Avoid pointing with your feet or touching someone with your feet.



Dress Code

While casual attire is generally acceptable, it's respectful to dress modestly when visiting temples.

TRANSPORTATION IN BANGKOK

Here are some tips to navigate Bangkok easily:

		Taxi	Widely available and relatively inexpensive. Be sure to use meter taxis or download the app "Grab."
		Tuk-tuks	A unique and fun way to explore the city, but be prepared to negotiate fares.
(BTS Skytrain	Convenient for exploring central Bangkok.
		MRT Subway	Covers a growing network of underground stations.
70)	200000	Public Buses	Affordable but can be crowded and time-consuming.
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OPERATION HOURS

Regular bank operation hours in Bangkok are from 8:30AM to 3:30PM, Monday to Friday. Several banks have special foreign-exchange offices that are open for longer hours, including weekends.





Shopping malls usually open **until 10PM** every day of the week. Hours for restaurants and cafés vary from place to place.

MONEY

Exchange booths and ATM machines are located at the **airport** and **around the city**. You may find them in shopping malls, supermarkets, and in the BTS or MRT stations.



Kindly note that ATMs usually **charge a fee of 200 Baht** for international cards not associated with the bank. For money exchange, remember to **always bring your passport along**.

SIM CARD



Tourist SIM cards can be purchased at the airport in the arrivals hall. Providers such as **True**, **AIS**, **and DTAC** are all reliable and the cost between them is similar.

SIM cards can also be bought at any 7-11 shop but you must bring your passport to obtain a SIM card.



WEATHER

The weather in Bangkok is hot and humid throughout the year. Average temperatures range between 24 to 31 degrees Celsius.
